The Important Days and Activities

1. Magha Puja Day is considered to be one of the most important Buddhist holy days, as it marks the occasion of the Lord Buddha transmitting the Ovada-Pattimokkha sermon. This sermon is regarded as the central teachings and heart of Buddhism.

Magha Puja day takes place on the full moon day of the 3rd lunar month, (approximately February).

2. Vesak Day is a commemoration of the day the Lord Buddha was born, became enlightened and passed away and has been officially recognized by the United Nation as "the world's internationally important day".

Vesak day takes place on the full moon day of the 6th lunar month, (approximately May).

3. Asalha Puja Day is an important day in Buddhism. It takes place on the full moon day of the 8th lunar month, (approximately July).

It commemorates 4 important occurrences which took place during the time of the Buddha:

- 3.1 The Lord Buddha delivered his first sermon.
- 3.2 The Lord Buddha gained his first disciple.
- 3.3 The coming into being of the first Bhikkhu.
- 3.4 The establishment of the Triple Gem.
- 4. Kathina Robe-Offering Ceremony is a wonderful Buddhist tradition that has been preserved for thousands of years since the Buddha's time. The Kathina Ceremony comes every year

and helds on the end of Buddhist Lent period, (approximately November).

- 5. First Sunday Ceremony We provide the meditation session for everyone and held the ceremony of offering the sustainable to the Lord Buddha. On this day we practice the Buddhist tradition such as alms offering ceremony.
- 6. Meditaion Classes are available for Danish people on every Saturday and Sunday.
- 7. We provide Buddhism Studies for any schools, associations, organizations available any time. (Please make an appointment first.)
