



Central Rituals

The rituals of the Church of England centre around our understanding that God in his infinite love has formed throughout the world a holy people for his own possession, a royal priesthood, a universal church that shares in the ministry of Jesus.

- A) We bring new Christians to Holy Baptism to share with them the Living Water of Jesus himself.
- B) We study and proclaim scripture as revealed in the Holy Bible.
- C) We minister the sacraments and help embody Christ in word and deed
- D) We are a visible place of welcome and transformation
- E) We believe in the ministry of reconciliation for if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation

We believe in sacraments as a means which God uses to show his grace on the road to salvation: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Healing and Anointing the sick are at heart.

Pastoral offices include Holy Baptism, Holy Matrimony, and Funerals.

Our doctrines are embedded in daily and Sunday liturgies.

Every Christian who professes Anglican faith is encouraged to strive to walk in the way of Christ through a discipline of private and corporate prayer, and study of God's word in Scripture.
