### THE ORDER OF SERVICE AND CHRISTIAN RITUALS FOR AKT NR.: 256578:

The order of service described below is to show the weekly activities of Triumphant Family International Church (TFIC).

#### 1. MEETING DAYS AND TIMES (TFIC)

These are the meeting days with their scheduled times for the TFIC.

**SUNDAYS:** Main Service and Fellowship 9:30am to 12:30am

**TUESDAYS:** Church Counselling with the Senior Pastor- 10am to 6pm

**WEDNESDAYS:** Evening prayer meeting-6pm to 7:30pm

**THURSDAYS:** Morning Prayer- 6am to 7am

**FRIDAYS:** Teaching Services: 6pm to 8pm

#### a. SUNDAYS (MAIN SERVICE/FELLOWSHIP)

The Sunday main service is the gathering of all TFIC members and visitors as the Word of God recommends:

*'Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching' (Hebrews 10:25)*

Below is the format of the order of service:

1. **Intercession Prayer:** This is the intercessory prayer which precedes the main service to commit the service into the hand of God. It often begins between the hours of 9:30am to 10am.
2. **Worship/Praises:** This section follows immediately after the intercession prayers from 10am to 10:45am. The TFIC choir leads us in singing praises and worship unto God.
3. **Fellowship/greetings:** It precedes the worship and praises (10:45am to 10:55am). Here the TFIC choir leads the church through music for the members to go round and greet one another.
4. **Announcement (10:55am – 11am):** The announcement is briefly to update the church on the weekly activities and upcoming programs.
5. **Offering and Tithing (11am-11:10am):** This is the section which allows members and visitors to voluntarily give some portion of their finances to support the day-to-day running of the church as the scripture stipulates: 1 Corinthians 16:1-2

*Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye. Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.*

6. **Communion:** *This comes immediately after the offering and tithe (11:10 to 11: 20am). TFIC partakes in the act of as a symbolism of thanks and in remembrance of the death of Jesus Christ. In doing so, we affirm our relationship through the new covenant. This ritual is done by the ministers preparing bread and wine, which is blessed by the pastor in charge of the service, and it is shared among the members in fellowship as the scripture states (1 Corinthians 10: 35; 1 Corinthians 11:17-33; John 6:53-56)*
7. **Special Song:** *It comes after communion (11:20-11:30am). The TFIC choir ministers in song to prepare the members and the Senior Pastors into receiving the word of God bring the word of God.*
8. **The Giving of the Message (11:30 to 12:25pm):** *This is where the word of God is preached and taught to the members in-depth. It is usually done by the pastors of TFIC*
9. **Closing prayer:** *The final prayer is said to end the service at 12:30pm.*
10. **Fellowship:** *The members gather at the children's department and the church hall to socialise and share a cup of tea or coffees served by the church as they depart to their respective homes.*

### **B. TUESDAYS COUNSELLING**

Tuesdays are designated for counselling with the senior pastor at the church office. Members are given the opportunity to meet with the senior pastor and discuss their challenges and problems so that he can offer his advice, wisdom, and recommendations. The members book appointments through the office of the senior pastors within the time frames of 10 a.m. to 18 hr.

### **C. WEDNESDAY PRAYER MEETING (18KL TO 19:30KL)**

The church gathers together to intercede for the nation, its leaders, and their activities, as well as pray for the church.

1 Timothy 2:1-4

*I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. 3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; 4 Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.*

### **D. MORNING PRAYERS:**

The morning prayers are a time for the members to pray into their day from 6 a.m. to 7 a.m. from their respective homes and offices. The morning prayers are organised online by pastors.

### **F. FRIDAY TEACHING SERVICES:**

The Friday teaching services entail these outlines:

**I. Opening prayers** (18:00 to 18:30): The service begins with prayers from 18:00pm to 18:30pm by the ministers.

**II: The teaching and question period:** After the pastor in charge of the services teaches the word of God, members are permitted to ask follow-up questions about the bible and the teaching.
